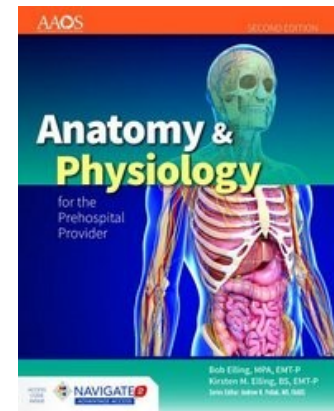

The George E. Moerkirk-Emergency Medicine Institute, a department of Lehigh Valley Health Network presents the "Anatomy & Physiology for the Prehospital Provider" This class will be mainly online with the exception of a few days of in class sessions for hands-on practical and testing.

Why Anatomy & Physiology (A&P)?

To properly assess and manage a patient, a prehospital provider must have a solid foundation in human A&P. In every patient encounter, you will call on your knowledge of A&P to help you understand the patient's presentation, anticipate or understand the suspected disease process and make a decision regarding the care you will provide.

Anatomy & Physiology is a pre-requisite for candidates interested in taking the GEM-EMI/LCCC Paramedic Program. This course will also benefit those EMT's who may be thinking of applying to the Paramedic Program within the next few years. To successfully complete this course for consideration into the Paramedic Program, the student must achieve a final grade of a 75% or better.

What if I've taken A&P in the past?

-If you withdrew from the Paramedic Program within the last 3 years and are looking to apply for readmission, you will be exempt from taking this class, providing you successfully passed the A&P portion with a 75% grade.

-If it's been 3—5 years since you successfully passed A&P in the Paramedic Program, you may "test-out".

-If you have taken a semester of a college A&P course within the last year, earning a "C" or better; that will be accepted.

-If you took college A&P more than a year ago and up to 5 years ago, you may "test-out" of the A&P class.

-If it has been greater than 5 years, you will have to take the A&P class.

Features and Benefits of A&P:

- Specifically geared to correlating A&P to how it relates to the EMS Provider

- Introduction of new terminology
- Pathophysiology tips describing common conditions encountered in the field and how they are treated
- Safety tips on keeping the prehospital provider safe in the field
- Information addressing how to manage patients in specific categories, such as the geriatric or pediatric patient requiring special consideration in treatment

Class Dates:

Classes will meet Monday and Wednesday evenings beginning **Wednesday, September 6th through October 30, 2023.** All classes will begin promptly at 6:30 p.m and finish at 10:00 p.m. When class does meet in person, it will be held at EMI, 2100 Mack Blvd. Allentown, PA 18105

Quizzes and a final exam will also be given throughout the course. In order to pass the course, you must achieve a grade of a 75% percent or greater. This course does not award college credits but will provide EMS Continuing Education credits.
