



## LVHN Health Plan Medication List

This list contains the names of medications, in alphabetical order, that are subject to one or more of the categories defined below.

### Definitions:

**Zero Dollar Generics (ZD)**- Generic medications that are covered 100% by the health plan.

**Preferred (PD)**- A medication that will have a lesser copay or co-insurance than other medications used for the same condition.

**Non-Preferred (NPD)**- A medication that will have a higher copay or co-insurance than other medications used for the same condition.

**Preferred Specialty (PSP)**- A specialty medication that will have a lesser copay or co-insurance than other specialty medications used for the same

**Specialty (SP)**- A medication that treats a rare, chronic, or complex condition. Because of their high cost, they are subject to a higher copay.

**Non-Preferred Specialty (NPSp)**- A specialty medication that will have a higher copay or co-insurance than other specialty medications.

**Prior Authorization (PA)**- A medication that needs additional clinical documentation submitted to Populytics Care Management from your physician for it to be covered.

**Step Therapy (ST)**- Trying other medications in the same drug class first before the more expensive medication will be covered by the health plan.

**Excluded (EX)**- Medications that are not covered by the health plan because other lower-cost, clinically equivalent alternatives are available.

**Limited Distribution (LD)**- Medications that are not available at Health Spectrum Pharmacy. If your physician has prescribed one of these medications, contact Populytics Care Management at (484) 862-3506 for details about how to obtain them.

New medications come on the market all the time. As a new drug is developed, it takes some time to make sure that it will work in the way it was intended. These new drugs can be costly. LVHN Health Plan is always looking for ways to keep costs down for members, while still making sure you get the safest, most effective and reasonably-priced drug available. One way we can do this is with a step therapy program. Step therapy is trying other medications in the same drug class (**Step 1**) first before “stepping up” to drugs that cost more (**Step 2**). We want to know that less expensive options don’t work before the plan will cover the more expensive drug. If your physician believes it is necessary for you to begin therapy with the more expensive option, they can contact Care Management at (484) 862-3506 to start the approval process.
