

Role Specific Dress Code

What should I wear?

Attire for Navigations Day 1 is business casual (no jeans and no sneakers). Classroom temperatures can vary, we suggest dressing in layers.

Patient Care Services Clinical Dress Code (Inpatient)

There are departments permitted to wear hospital provided scrubs.

Administrative Policy: Dress Code, will be discussed in Navigations for a list of those departments.

RN/Newly Licensed RN – Solid navy blue with white LVHN-branded embroidery on all tops and jackets. Units associated with the Children's Hospital at LVHN have been approved to have that branded logo embroidery, also in white. No other type or color of embroidery is permitted.

- Solid navy blue top with LVHN-branded embroidery, worn at all times
- Solid navy blue bottoms (pants or skirt), worn at all times
- Solid navy blue scrub jacket with LVHN-branded embroidery, if desired
- Solid navy blue or solid white shirt (long- or short-sleeved) under the top, if desired
- **Technical Partner/Certified Nursing Assistant** Solid Royal Blue scrub top and Royal Blue or White pant. White sneakers/nursing shoes. Note: Technical Partners working in the Emergency Department at Cedar Crest wear solid Caribbean Blue scrub top and pant.
- Mental Health Technician Any color or printed scrub top and bottom or business casual attire, white sneakers or nursing shoes.
- Patient Transporter Scrub top with hospital logo. Tops may be purchased at the Health Spectrum Pharmacy at either site; prices vary depending on size. A hospital ID badge is required to purchase a shirt. Pants should be Khaki scrub pants. Sneakers or shoes are permitted and are to be leather or vinyl in solid white, black or brown.
- Patient Observation Assistant/Professional Student Nursing Patient Observation Assistant Solid Burgundy scrub top and Black or Khaki pant. White sneakers/nursing shoes.

- **Respiratory Therapy** Charcoal Gray scrub top and pants.
- Administrative Partner Solid black scrub top and pant. Note: Administrative Partners working in the Emergency Department at Cedar Crest wear solid Chocolate Brown scrub top and pants. Sneakers or shoes are to be leather or vinyl in solid white, black or brown.
